ITINERARY

DAY 1

Arrival in Toulouse

Individual arrival to Toulouse in the late afternoon. Toulouse is also called the "ville rose" because of the reddish stone of many buildings. One sight is the Basilica St-Sernin de Toulouse, a culinary speciality is the duck breast with green beans.

DAY 2

Toulouse - Castelnaudary

Many buildings are built with red bricks in Toulouse, therefore this city is also named "ville rose". A wonderful place of interest is the basilica St. Sernin de Toulouse. A culinary delicacy is the duck breast with green beans.


