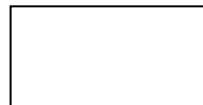

DAY
1

Arrival to Romanshorn | Romanshorn – Münchwilen

Luggage drop-off in Romanshorn. The rolling hills of the Oberthurgau: apples and pears in plenty, past the beautiful town of Bischofszell into the Hinterthurgau to Münchwilen.

 approx. 40 km  415 m  300 m

DAY
2

Münchwilen – Zürich-Regensdorf

Useful but unpredictable water from richly forested Tösstal. Culturally and industrially confident Winterthur, a city without airs and graces. Whether with a gentle murmur or a roar, the rut of the «silver birds» announce the arrival of Zurich.

DAY
3

Zürich-Regensdorf – Olten

Through the Furt-valley of the Limmat, the bathing spot Baden, and on to marvel at the Gothic stained glass windows in Königsfelden and yellow irises of the river Aare floodplain, followed by a leisurely ride on the Aare dam to Olten.

DAY
4

Olten – Biel

Past baroque-town Solothurn along the meandering Aare to Dreiseenland (three lakes country). Just 130 years ago, this landscape was redesigned by man: the lake level lowered and marshes drained. Seeland is now the scene of intense vegetable cultivation.

DAY
5**Biel – Murten**




A pleasant ride through the three lakes country. The little medieval town of Murten on the south-east bank of the lake of the same name has preserved its original appearance, with the picturesque alleyways of the Old Town and the pleasant shady arcades. You briefly leave the Mittelland route and travel on regional routes to Murten.

DAY
6**Murten – Yverdon-les-Bains**




From medieval Murten to the small city Avenches. The small town of Avenches lies in the wide Broye Plain between the Lakes of Neuchâtel and Murten in the canton of Vaud near the border to the canton of Fribourg. This former capital of Roman Helvetia has a rich and valuable heritage from Roman times.

Now back to Lake Neuchâtel. chirping in the reeds, waves lapping at the gentle shore, the Jura is shimmering in the distance. Over 100 species of birds breed in the Grande Caricaie, the 40-km-long marsh and reed belt along the southern shores of the lake.

DAY
7**Yverdon-les-Bains – Lausanne | Departure or extension**

Flat and fertile: Plaine de l'Orbe, framed by Roman mosaics and the rolling hills of Vaud. In Mormont, the watershed of the Rhone and Rhine. Change of scene from the wild waters of the Venoge to the small silver «sea» of Lac Léman.

 approx. 55 – 65 km  585 – 595 m  590 – 595 m

TOUR CHARACTER

The route is mostly flat and leads through the Swiss mittelland. It is perfect for family bike tours with children. Mostly car-free and on natural field- and forest paths.

Information

Arrival/Departure:

- Arrival by public transport in Romanshorn. In case of direct arrival: Suitcases must be handed in at the luggage counter by 10 a.m. at the latest.
- Departure by public transport from Lausanne. In case of direct departure: Suitcases will be returned to the luggage counter by 5 p.m. at the latest.

Arrival by train:

Leave the car at home! For every bike, biking or hiking tour in Switzerland, you will receive an SBB coupon per participant, which you can use to **deduct CHF 10 from the ticket price** for traveling by train. The reduction can be obtained in the SBB online store or in the SBB app.

On many trips, we use the luggage counters at the stations at the beginning and at the end to hand over the suitcases. You can conveniently combine this right away when you arrive by train. **If you are a GA owner, you can provide this information when booking. We will credit you the amount on the invoice.** If you don't need the coupon for the trip itself, you can use it during the year.

Unfortunately, a retroactive refund is not possible for administrative reasons.
